

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### General Conditions

Central Coast Stadium is dedicated to providing a safe and enjoyable environment for all patrons. In support of this, the following Conditions of Entry will be enforced, which may also be supplemented by additional specific Conditions of Entry printed on a patron's ticket or otherwise notified for certain events.

In line with Liquor Licence conditions and industry best practice, there will be a screening process conducted for all patrons upon entry to the stadium – which include bag checks, and electronic screening.

Central Coast Stadium Management reserves the right to carry out such personal checks of any patron who enters or exits the stadium. Patrons refusing to participate in the search process will be excluded from entry;

Alcohol is not permitted to be taken into or out of the stadium;

Smoking is not permitted within the stadium; there is a designated smoking area on the ground floor Eastern side of the stadium outside next to the Ticketek office, anyone caught smoking inside the stadium may be asked to leave and refused re-entry.

Central Coast Stadium Management advises that you may be recorded on either commercial broadcast or CCTV (Closed Circuit Television) upon entry and throughout the licensed area during your time within the Arena; the footage may be recorded and used if required by safety and / or security purposes.

Events at Central Coast Stadium may involve a level of recreational risk associated with a crowded environment, which may result in personal injury from time-to-time. All patrons purchasing tickets or attending events at the Stadium are asked to assess their own risk prior to entry;

There are strictly no pass outs for this event, once you exit the venue there is no re-entry allowed.

### Prohibited Items

The following prohibited items are not allowed in Central Coast Stadium. These items may change, without notice and at the complete discretion of Management in conjunction with each event and the venue hirer updated versions will be displayed at all entry points:

- Specified Bags smaller than the approved size of 30cm H x 30cm L x 22cm W (A4 sized) are permitted, though subject to a search procedure upon arrival, bags larger than this must be cloaked prior to entry\*- this rule only applies to concerts
- Baggage sizer's are available upon entry to verify the approved sizes permitted inside the Stadium
- Professional cameras or cameras with a detachable lens telephoto lens or a lens that extends more than 5cm from the body of the camera (flash photography is not permitted)
- Recording devices
- Selfie Sticks / monopods or tripods
- Alcohol or illegal substances of any kind
- Cans \*- this rule only applies to concerts and A-League events
- Bottles- 1 sealed bottle of water permitted per person \*- this rule only applies to concerts
- Eskies / hard cased cooler bags\*- this rule only applies to concerts
- Weapons of any kind, including any item that can be used as a projectile
- Chains and spiked wrist / neck bands or studded belts
- Fireworks or flares

- Laser Pointers, permanent marker / felt type pens, scissors or aerosol canisters
- Drones and or other remote controlled devices
- Glow sticks and illuminating objects such as LED signage
- Motorbike helmets or balaclavas
- Horns, trumpets, sirens, whistles or Vuvuzela type of noise making devices
- Flags or signs larger than 1m x 1m, flag pole not attached and content must not be offensive in any nature
- Umbrellas
- Strollers, prams and baby capsules- can be cloaked once inside the venue opposite turnstile entry points
- Vacuum flasks of any material
- Bicycles, skateboards / skates
- Commercial food (fast food items or food purchased from a full service restaurant) excluding items purchased by approved vendors and / or Stadium catering outlets
- Commercial quantities of packet food
- Electronic cigarettes (e-cig or e-cigarettes), personal vaporisers, electronic nicotine systems or any other vaporisers
- Animals (excluding service animals)

## **Liquor Licence**

Patrons entering Central Coast Stadium are advised that:

- The Stadium is a licensed area / premises
- Intoxicated persons will be refused entry / evicted from the Stadium / Licensed Premises
- No external alcoholic beverages will be permitted entry to the Stadium / Licensed Premises
- The following forms of ID are acceptable within the Stadium:
  - A driver's or rider's license or permit (issued by an Australian State or Territory or any foreign country)
  - Australian passport or a foreign passport issued by another country
  - NSW photo card (issued by Roads and Maritime Services NSW)
  - Proof of age card issued by a public authority of the commonwealth or of another State or Territory for the purpose of attesting to a person's identity and age
- It is an offence for minors to purchase or consume alcohol
- It is an offence to sell to or supply minors with alcohol
- Checking procedures will apply at all entrances to prevent prohibited items from entering
- Drinks are required to be decanted into approved plastic cups for some events or lids removed from bottles once purchased.

## **Refusal of Entry**

For the safety, comfort and enjoyment of all patrons, Central Coast Stadium Management reserves the right to:

- Refuse Entry to any persons deemed to be intoxicated and/or disorderly
- Refuse entry to any unauthorised persons
- Refuse entry of items which have the potential to cause injury or public nuisance
- Refuse entry to any person who purchases an event ticket from any unauthorised source, including a ticket scalper
- Refuse entry to any person who presents an invalid ticket
- Refuse Entry to any group as designated by Police or persons on a banned persons list supplied by the industry governing body.
